Subject:- Grant of Conditional permission to Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst. ID:-AYU0128) for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 27.08.2024-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the **Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh** by vide a letter reference no. **Prashasan-01/2024/3740-41 dated 27.08.2024** to the commission in respect of Grant of conditional permission to **Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst. ID:-AYU0128)** with **48 seats (60 seats including EWS) [instead of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS)]** due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in conditional permission with seat reduction letter dated 08.07.2024.
- Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the hearing letter was issued to the **Principal, Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh** vide Commission's letter **Ref. No. NCISM/Comm/OPT Appeal/ (2024-25)-(MP) dated 17.09.2024** to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on **18.09.2024** in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the conditional permission with seat reduction letter dated **08.07.2024** issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on **18.09.2024** and on behalf of the college, **Dr. Ajit Pal Singh Chauhan ,Principal of the college and Dr. Sanjay Kumar Mishra ,Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Ayush** attended the hearing.
- The hearing committee sought clarification from the **representative of the Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh** regarding shortcomings mentioned in the **conditional permission with seat reduction letter dated 08.07.2024** issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM and observation made by the hearing committee which is as under:-

16321/2016 in honourable Supreme Court, to the promotion to higher posts have been held up in all the Govt. departments including the AYUSH. To meet out this challenge, many of Govt. Departments have given charges to higher posts to incumbent employees/officers and the same is under active consideration in AYUSH department as well.

It is further submitted that NCISM was pleased to consider the case of Madhya Pradesh especially in the last academic session 2023-24, where in the following provisions were made.

As per the special policy in case of UG course: Those teaching faculties who are working as Lecturers or Assistant Professors but have more than five year of experience or working as Reader or Associate Professor but have more than 10 years of experience will be considered in place of Associate Professor or Professor as ever the case may be. But teaching faculties who are considered as above are not entitled for higher cadre experience". In this regards following faculties have more than required years of experience. We In this regards seek your kind attention that following 04 faculties have more than required years of experience and could be considered as higher faculties as they have been considered in the previous session (23-24).

It is respectfully submitted that, as per Govt. Policy and the directives issued by Department of AYUSH, all the eligible teachers are going to be upgraded with their pay scales under Time pay scheme. Accordingly in compliance to recent directives of Department of AYUSH Govt. M.P. (vide no. F 1-51/2021/1/59 (1776), dated 10.06.2024.

However, the authority stated that, he will fulfil the deficiency shortly and also requested that, in government college poor/meritorious students are admitted.

Submission may be considered with a view to prevent losses to poor students.

*** It is submitted that the applicant has stated that, they will submit an undertaking with regard to the fulfillment of the shortcomings equipment's/instruments as post hearing submission.**

Further, the applicant has submitted an undertaking vide ref. no. 2024/4-Est/3281-84 dated 01.10.2024 which is authorized by Dr. Saloni Sidana, Commissioner, Directorate Ayush Madhya Pradesh. For procurement Govt. college needs to fulfill some protocol from State government. Therefore, post hearing submission as an undertaking is considered.

Since the process of fulfilment of shortcoming of higher and lower teaching faculties is going on so kindly consider it.

In view of above, it is humbly requested to consider the case and withdraw the reduction of 20% and permit the full quota of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG course for AYU0128 [Govt. (Auto.) Ashtang Ayurved College and Hospital, Indore Madhya Pradesh).

Further, the authority has submitted an undertaking vide ref. no 2024/4-Est/3281-84 dated 01.10.2024 which is authorized by Dr. Saloni Sidana, Commissioner, Directorate Ayush Madhya Pradesh stating that they will fulfil all the shortcomings.

4. The submission made by the **representative of Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh** and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to **consider the appeal regarding Grant of Conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course to Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID:- AYU0128) for the academic session 2024-25 on the basis of undertaking vide ref. no 2024/4-Est/3281-84 dated 01.10.2024 which is authorized by Dr. Saloni Sidana, Commissioner, Directorate Ayush Madhya Pradesh stating that they will fulfill all shortcomings as per the concerned acts & regulations.**
5. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM **vide letter no. NCISM/Comm/OPT Appeal/ (2024-25)- (MP) dated 08.10.2024** to grant conditional permission to **Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0128) with 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 as per the concerned acts & regulations.
6. Therefore, conditional permission is granted to **Shaskiya Swashasi Ashtanga Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Lokmanya Nagar, Indore-452009, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID-AYU0128) with 60 seats (75 Seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course** for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats** of the permitted intake capacity of **60 seats (75 Seats including EWS)** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
8. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the

college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26 as per rules:
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
